Continuous Professional Development of Teachers

Shikshaantar is the Foundation's flagship training program for educators. This initiative targets all critical stakeholders in schools - including teachers, educators, administrators, and leaders. The program prioritises the importance of integrating physical, mental, social, and emotional well-being for both educators and learners.

Central to Shikshaantar are the In-service Teacher Education Institutes (ITEI), which marked its 10 year anniversary in 2023. In collaboration with government departments, ITEIs serve as the bridge between research and practice, infusing new ideas, strategies, and perspectives into teacher education curriculum and classroom-based teaching. Over the years, the ITEIs have created a platform for peer learning. The impact of Shikshaantar is evident in the significant improvement in teacher learning.

"As a teacher, maximising student output is almost instinctive," says Paval. A teacher for over a decade now, she understands the education system and her role in it. She realised that she needed help to address each student's needs better.

In the last few months after ITEI-East's intervention, in her own words, her classroom has undergone a renewed sense of purpose and accomplishment, a model worth emulating by everyone else. Her students in the class tutor each other under her supervision, which she feels has boosted the overall morale of her classroom. "Once the students are confident in the content, I make them sit in groups and work on questions. After this, they correct each other's work. This model allows them to learn without hesitation," she reasons.

Recalling the idea of using a student's strengths, one of the most significant achievements she mentioned was helping a student who failed in all her subjects. She says she learned about multiple intelligences at ITEI-East, and suddenly she realised that a student of hers who was very good at memorising song lyrics could use music and performance to learn the content of other subjects as well.

She credits the Institute for her success. The ITEI sessions are continuing to support other teachers like her to bring transformation in classrooms.

Skilling Youth for a Better Tomorrow

SMART (Skills for Market Training Program) is the Foundation's flagship Skill Development Program for youth from underserved communities across the country. The program addresses the gap between the skilling sector and industry requirements with well-structured training programs and placement opportunities for the students.

With a strategic focus on major cities nationwide, SMART, marked by well-defined processes, has maintained an impressive annual placement rate of 70-75% since its inception in 2012.

The program operates as a directly implemented initiative through SMART Academies and as a partner-implemented program through SMART Centres.

Students are offered training in more than 15 domains, including Healthcare, Logistics, and the Services Industry. Aligned with the Government of India's Skill India Mission and UN-mandated Sustainable Development Goals (4, 5, 8 & 17), SMART is committed to establishing a nationwide yardstick for an employability program.

SMART has focused on bringing more women under its ambit and increasing workforce participation for women in India. This has happened through multiple ongoing projects, including a womenonly Tech Mahindra SMART Academy for Healthcare in Navi Mumbai.

Changing the norm

The daughter of a daily wage worker, Wahida Parveen had dreams; she aspired to be financially independent. Once she was a graduate, her parents wanted to follow the norm and get her married. But she had other plans.

A door-to-door TMF-Reach India Trust mobilisation campaign caught her interest and she saw skill development / vocational education as the means to realise her dream. Her parents were initially reluctant, but were eventually convinced by the counsellors of the program to let her enrol.

During the 4-month course, Wahida dedicated herself to her education. After completing her training, she was recruited by a leading food delivery organisation as a Senior Customer Care Executive. Today, Wahida is not only financially independent, but also contributes to the family income.

Expressing her happiness, Wahida says "I want to be a role model for girls in my community who want to work but are unable to because of social taboos and barriers. I hope to bring positive change in the minds of people who want to restrict girls from choosing a career. I want my story to inspire others".

Making Learning Inclusive

The number of Persons with Disabilities (PwD) is close to 27 Million in India, according to the last 2011 census. Tapping their potential with skill development, learning opportunities is critical for an inclusive and equitable India. ARISE+ (All Round Improvement in School Education for Children with Disabilities) and SMART+ (Skills for Market Training for Persons with Disabilities) lead our interventions in disability.

ARISE+ projects support children with disability (Speech and hearing, Visual and intellectual) within the age group 0 -18 years with education support. Key features include regular counselling services, therapy, special education curriculum, and the integration of assistive learning technology. Our holistic approach to disability extends to parents, teachers, and other caregivers closely associated with the children. The program ensures they receive counselling and training in essential techniques for caring for these children and young adults.

SMART+ centres provide vocational training to Persons with Disabilities (PwDs), preparing them for employment opportunities. Specially designed curriculums, training programs, and exposure visits are helping many youth with disabilities step into professional careers and craft independent lives for themselves.

A significant number of our beneficiaries comprise women and girls with disabilities. With our unwavering focus on breaking down barriers in the disability sector, we are committed to fostering inclusivity at every step.

Our ARISE+ Alumnus Dinesh Shines in the Special Olympics 2023

Dinesh Kumar, a former student of our ARISE+ partner, The Spastics Society of Tamil Nadu (SPASTN), made waves in the recently concluded Berlin Special Olympics by winning two Silver medals in the 50m Breaststroke and 4x25 Freestyle Relay with the Indian swimming squad.

Dinesh joined SPASTN in mid-2015 after his previous school turned him down. As a young adult with autism, he struggled to adapt to mainstream school settings. He also refused to enroll in the National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) for his senior secondary classes. Teachers at the Autism Academic Unit gradually transitioned him over two months, and he completed his 12th exam in 2020.

After observing Dinesh, ARISE+ trainers recommended enrolling him in swimming classes to help regulate his sensory needs. With his family's support, he excelled in district, state, and national-level competitions.

After 8 years of continuous hard work, grit and perseverance, Dinesh got selected for Special Olympics 2023. He came back to India with two Silver medals and has made the country proud!

Saajhi Samajh (Shared Understanding) aims to establish a comprehensive advocacy platform through discussions. These crosslearning sessions address a range of issues directly impacting the Foundation's beneficiaries and society at large. In a world that demands resilience, acknowledging the importance of mental health is the first step towards building a foundation of strength and empowerment.

Mind@Ease, brings together counselling service providers on a single platform, facilitating easy user access to their services. The website is a valuable resource to spread awareness through an accessible resource repository.

The Foundation has teamed up with 25+ organisations providing diverse services, including counselling, therapy and helpline support. Our platform hosts reputable and credible organisations offering counselling services in various categories, including mental health & well-being, career guidance, job assistance and livelihood support.

Awareness Programs have also helped beneficiaries to manage mental health distress. These programs cover Psychoeducation, Sensitisation and Psychological First Aid (PFA). Over 55 trainers and counsellors have been tutored through our programs. Our Champions of Mental Health serve as ambassadors for Mind@Ease and create a classroom peer support system in the SMART Centers of Tech Mahindra Foundation. Identified and trained, they generate awareness, conduct social-emotional activities, and foster safe spaces for students.
